## Rules of Poster Awards at EuroMOF2021 conference

- 1. *The Poster Awards* are offered to students (any education level before obtaining PhD), who are the presenting authors of outstanding posters.
- 2. A prize of 1000PLN is awarded to the best posters (the number of awards will be announced at the beginning of the conference).
- 3. Posters must be uploaded on the conference platform by the authors according to general rules (deadline: September 1, 2021) and pre-registered in the competition:
- Send an e-mail to <a href="mailto:euromof2021@uj.edu.pl">euromof2021@uj.edu.pl</a> with the subject: **'CONSIDER FOR POSTER AWARD SXPXX'** where SX stands for the section number, PXX is your poster number. This message must include:
  - i) the name of the poster author,
  - ii) the poster title,
  - iii) declaration of eligibility (declaration of student's status).
- Enter a note: 'CONSIDER FOR POSTER AWARD' in the first slide of the poster;
- 4. **Posters will be judged throughout September 6 -14, 2021**, and the Awards will be announced during the Closing ceremony on **September 15, 2021**.
- 5. Posters will be judged by an international scientific jury consisting of ca. 10 members headed by a chairperson. The jury will take several aspects into account including:
  - i) Clear objectives/motivation and conclusions/message
  - ii) Clarity, quality and reliability of the research and results
  - iii) general attractiveness of the poster (e.g. aesthetics; readability; balance between text and images; balance between introduction, results and conclusions; accuracy of images)
  - iv) oral explanation (including clarity, knowledge and enthusiasm) by the student during poster session

It is also planned to fund the audience award. The details will be given on the conference platform.

6. The organizer retains the right not to award any prize in case of doubtful situations or unpredicted circumstances.
